AN ACT concerning the solemnization of marriages and amending R. S. 37:1-13.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State

2 of New Jersey:

1 1. R. S. 37:1–13 is amended to read as follows:

 $\mathbf{2}$ 37:1-13. Each judge of a [Federal] federal district court, judge of a county district court, [magistrate] judge of a municipal court, 3 judge of the superior court, judge of a tax court and any mayor, or 4 chairman of any township committee or village president of this $\mathbf{5}$ State, and every minister of every religion, and Ljudges of the 6 criminal judicial district courts in counties wherein such courts 7 are or may be established and judges of the juvenile and domestic 8 •9 relations courts or family courts in counties in which such courts are or may be established, are hereby authorized to solemnize mar-10 riage between such persons as may lawfully enter into the matri-11 monial relation; and every religious society, institution or organi-1213 zation in this State may join together in marriage such persons according to the rules and customs of the society, institution or 14 organization. 15

1 2. This act shall take effect April 1, 1983.

STATEMENT
