AN ACT concerning special motor vehicle registration plates for members of ***[the United States Naval Reserve]*** **military reserve units** and supplementing chapter 3 of Title 39 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Upon the application of any person who is a resident of this
2 State and who is an active member of ***[the United States Naval**
3 **Reserve]*** **a military reserve unit** as certified by the ***[United**
4 **States Department of the Navy]*** **appropriate military authority**,
4A the director shall issue for the motor vehicle owned by the person
5 special registration plates, of a design to be approved by the
6 director and at a fee to be prescribed by the director, identifying
7 the holder as a member of ***[the "Naval Reserve"]*** **a military*
8 *reserve unit** in addition to the registration number and other
9 markings or identification otherwise prescribed by law.

1 2. The director shall promulgate rules and regulations govern-
2 ing the issuance and use of these registration plates and providing
3 for their surrender by persons who cease to be either members of
4 the ***[United States Naval Reserve]*** **a military reserve unit** or
5 residents of this State.

1 3. This act shall take effect on the one hundred eightieth day
2 following enactment.

STATE OF NEW JERSEY

DATED: FEBRUARY 28, 1983

This bill directs the Director of the Division of Motor Vehicles to issue special license plates to active members of military reserve units who are residents of this State. The bill also provides that the director shall promulgate rules and regulations governing the issuance and use of these registration plates and providing for their surrender by persons who cease to be either members of a military reserve unit or residents of New Jersey.

STATE OF NEW JERSEY

DATED: DECEMBER 13, 1982

As amended by the Senate Law, Public Safety and Defense Committee, this bill would authorize the Director of the Division of Motor Vehicles to issue special license plates to active members of a military reserve unit who are residents of this State.

Without the committee's amendment, the bill would have authorized the granting of special license plates only to members of the United States Naval Reserve.

Governor Thomas H. Kean today signed the following bills:

A-272, sponsored by Assemblyman Walter Kern, R-Bergen, to ensure access to cable television service by tenants of condominium associations, housing cooperatives, and owners of mobile home parks.

A-1721, sponsored by Assemblyman Elliott Smith, R-Somerset, to permit assessments for local improvement to be paid over a period of 20 years, rather than 10 years.

S-1763, sponsored by Senator Joseph Hirkala, D-Passaic, to authorize the Division of Motor Vehicles to issue special license plates to active members of a military reserve unit who are residents of New Jersey.

A-1512, sponsored by Assemblyman Joseph Patero, D-Somerset, to appropriate \$15 million from the Water Supply Bond Act to finance improvements to the Delaware and Raritan Canal.

A-1269, sponsored by Assemblyman Thomas Cowan, D-Hudson, placing certain employees of Hudson County Youth House under Civil Service.

S-1446, sponsored by Senator Wayne Dumont, R-Warren, which requires the tax court to send copies of judgments of notice to the collector and county tax administrator of the county in which the property at issue is situated.
