INTRODUCED JULY 11, 1983

BENNETT, Assemblywoman MUHLER and Assemblyman

AN ACT concerning the Marine Academy of Science and Technology,  
and supplementing P. L. 1982, c. 146 (C. 18A:54C-1 et seq.).

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. The assets of the Marine Academy of Science and Technology  
2 operating under the auspices of an area vocational technical school  
3 in a county of the fifth class having a population of not less than  
4 450,000 shall be transferred to the county vocational technical school  
5 board and shall continue to operate as a full-time program as pro-  
6 vided under P. L. 1982, c. 146 (C. 18A:54C-1 et seq.) except that  
7 the costs shall be paid as follows:

8 a. Local districts shall pay tuition in an amount equal to the  
9 district's net current expense budget per pupil for each pupil  
10 attending plus any amount of any category of State aid payable to  
11 the district for that pupil but not to exceed an amount equal to the  
12 per pupil cost of the Marine Academy of Science and Technology:  
13 and

14 b. If the costs of the program exceed the amounts raised by  
15 tuition, the additional costs shall be paid by the county vocational  
16 technical school except that if the additional costs, when calculated  
17 on an average per pupil basis, exceed the average tuition payment  
18 by \$750.00, the county vocational technical school may assess the  
19 local district, for each pupil attending, an amount equal to the  
20 amount by which the additional costs exceed \$750.00.

1 2. All tuition shall be forwarded by the sending district to the  
2 county vocational technical school district which has established  
3 the Marine Academy of Science and Technology.

1 3. Any costs of the Marine Academy of Science and Technology  
2 accruing to any district shall not be subject to any limitations  
3 pursuant to section 25 of P. L. 1975, c. 212 (C. 18A:7A-25) for  
4 the 1983-84 school year.

1 4. Notwithstanding any provisions in P. L. 1982, c. 146 (C.  
2 18A:54C-1 et seq.), the Commissioner of Education shall recalculate  
3 State aid for the 1983-84 school year for all districts whose pupils  
4 were in attendance at the Marine Academy of Science and Tech-  
5 nology on September 30, 1982 by removing the pupils from the  
6 resident enrollment of the district operating the Marine Academy  
7 and adding the pupils to the resident enrollment of each pupil's  
8 district of residence; and the commissioner shall increase the 1982-  
9 83 net current expense budget of each of the sending school  
10 districts by the estimated tuition to be paid to the county vocational  
11 technical school for the 1983-84 school year except that the above  
12 adjustments shall not affect any other state, or district calculations  
13 that have been made for the 1983-84 school year.

1 5. The board of education of the county vocational technical  
2 school shall determine the admission policies of the Marine Acad-  
3 emy of Science and Technology except that the places available  
4 shall be allocated in a fair and equitable manner and the method of  
5 allocation shall not affect the pupils who enrolled in the program  
6 prior to the 1983-84 school year. Pupils from other counties may  
7 be admitted so far as the facilities permit except that the local  
8 districts' tuition for out-of-county pupils shall include the total  
9 costs as approved by the Commissioner of Education.

1 6. Transportation for pupils attending the Marine Academy of  
2 Science and Technology shall be provided by the district in which  
3 the pupil resides.

1 7. This act shall take effect immediately.

The Governor also signed:

A-3370, sponsored by Assemblyman Raymond Lesniak, D-Union, which amends the New Jersey Legal Services Insurance Act of 1981 to permit hospital service corporations to transact the business of legal insurance. The bill has the effect of allowing Blue Cross/Blue Shield to join other insurance carriers in offering legal services insurance.
