- A SUPPLEMENT to the "Spill Compensation and Control Act," approved January 6, 1977 (P. L. 1976, c. 141; C. 58:10-23.11 et seq.).
- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
- 2 of New Jersey:
- 1. The State Auditor shall conduct an annual audit of the fund
- 2 pursuant to the provisions of chapter 24 of Title 52 of the Revised
- 3 Statutes. This audit, together with any recommendations on prac-
- 4 tices or procedures to promote or guarantee the fiscal integrity of
- 5 the fund, shall be submitted to the Governor and the Legislature,
- 6 and to the General Assembly Agriculture and Environment Com-
- 7 mittee and the Senate Energy and Environment Committee, or
- 8 their designated successors. The audit for fiscal year 1981 shall
- 9 be due within 60 days of the effective date of this act, and each
- 10 successive annual audit shall be due on \*[September 1]\* \*or before
- 11 December 31\*.
- 1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
