This bill provides that dental radiographs shall only be used for diagnostic or treatment purposes, not to verify the performance of dental services.

Assembly Bill No. 710 -- which provides for the regulation of dental radiographs.

Assembly Bill No. 1367 -- which changes the effective date of the pre-school handicapped program.

Assembly Bill No. 1585 -- which provides that the results of the study and mapping of riparian land be filed with the register of deeds and mortgages in counties wherein the register, rather than the county clerk, is the principal recording officer for official records, papers and documents.

Assembly Bill No. 1660 -- which amends the "Public School Education Act" (P.L. 1975, c. 212) to permit school districts which have tentative approval based on an assessment by the county superintendent to report students on September 30, 1982 and anticipate State categorical aid in the budget submitted to the county superintendent in January.

Assembly Joint Resolution No. 12 -- which establishes a Local Expenditure Limitations Technical Review Commission to study the local spending limitations formulas imposed on local governments of this State.

Assembly Joint Resolution No. 46 -- which establishes a commission to study the effects of "caps" on local governments.
