AN ACT concerning the filing of riparian maps and amending
P. L. 1968, c. 404.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Section 90 of P. L. 1968, c. 404 (C. 13:1B-13.4) is amended
2 to read as follows:

3 90. Upon completion of each separate study and survey, the
4 council shall publish a map portraying the results of its study
5 and clearly indicating those lands designated by the council as
6 State-owned lands. Copies of each such map and study shall be
7 filed with the Secretary of State and sent to the clerk of each county
8 *or to the register of deeds and mortgages, whoever shall have the*
9 *responsibility as the recording officer of the county*, and to the
10 governing body of each municipality whose political boundaries
11 include lands shown on the map. Such maps and studies shall be
12 available for public inspection.

13 The council shall also cause to be published at least once in a
14 newspaper circulating in each county whose political boundaries
15 include lands designated as State-owned lands a list of those parcels
16 designated in whole or in part as State-owned lands.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT
