AN ACT concerning county detectives and amending N. J. S.  
2A:157-4.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. N. J. S. 2A:157-4 is amended to read as follows:

2 2A:157-4. a. In counties of the second class having a population  
3 in excess of **[500,000]** *580,000* there may be appointed not in excess  
4 of **[28]** *40* county detectives, of whom one may be designated chief  
5 of county detectives, one deputy chief of county detectives, **[one**  
6 **captain]** \***[two captains]**\* \**one captain*\* of county detectives, six  
7 lieutenants of county detectives and **[four]** \***[10]**\* \**four*\* ser-  
8 geants of county detectives.

9 b. In counties of the second class having a population between  
10 **[460,000 and 500,000]** *500,000 and 580,000* there may be appointed  
11 not in excess of **[24]** *28* county detectives, of whom one may be  
12 designated chief of county detectives, one deputy chief of county  
13 detectives, **[four captains]** *one captain* of county detectives **[and]**,  
14 six lieutenants of county detectives *and four sergeants of county*  
15 *detectives.*

16 c. In counties of the second class having a population between  
17 **[410,000 and 460,000]** *460,000 and 500,000*, there may be appointed  
18 not in excess of 28 county detectives, of whom one may be designated  
19 chief of county detectives, **[one captain]** *one deputy chief of county*  
20 *detectives, four captains* of county detectives, **[four]** *and six* lieu-

29 e. *In the counties of the second class having a population of*  
30 *400,000 or under, there may be appointed not in excess of 12 county*  
31 *detectives of whom one may be designated chief of county detec-*  
32 *tives, one captain of county detectives, and three lieutenants of*  
33 *county detectives.*

34 ~~[e.]~~ f. Their annual salaries shall be fixed as follows: chief of  
35 county detectives, not less than \$9,500.00; deputy chief of county  
36 detectives not less than \$9,000.00; captain of county detectives, not  
37 less than \$8,000.00; lieutenant of county detectives, not less than  
38 \$7,000.00; sergeant of county detectives, not less than \$6,500.00; and  
39 other county detectives, not less than \$6,000.00.
