An Act concerning county boards of taxation, and amending R. S. 54:3-2.

1.	Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State

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STATEMENT

This bill would permit county tax board members who have served at least 10 years to substitute their experience on the board for the training course requirements of N. J. S. A. 54:1–35.28. The bill would permit these experienced members to continue their current term of appointment to the board past June 30, 1982, and to be reappointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate.
