- 6 1. Section 46 of P.L.1984, c.171 (C.17:13-124) is amended to read as follows:
 - 46. a. A Credit Union Advisory Council is created which shall consult with, advise, and make recommendations to the commissioner on matters pertaining to the chartering, operation and supervision of credit unions.
- b. The council shall consist of [five] seven persons to be 12 appointed by the Governor, with the advice and consent of the 13 14 Senate, who are members of the State chartered and federally chartered credit unions within the State, at least two of whom shall 15 be members of federally chartered credit unions within the State 16 ¹and at least four of whom shall be members of State chartered 17 <u>credit unions within the State</u>¹.
