Current law requires persons installing, improving, repairing or maintaining medical gas piping within licensed health care facilities to be certified by the State Board of Examiners of Master Plumbers. However, this certification requirement is limited to work or instruction on medical gas piping intended for patient use within licensed health care facilities that is located after the source valve.

This bill expands current professional certification requirements to cover persons installing, improving, repairing or maintaining medical gas piping within the offices of licensed dentists and dental clinics, and within animal or veterinary facilities.
