

MS. MC DANIEL: Jessie McDaniel, Middlesex County Probation Officer.


MR. GONZALEZ: Daniel Gonzalez on behalf of Pablo Machado who is present, Judge.

The recommendation by probation is continued probation. It seems that the violations that Mr. Machado has with regards to failures to report and failures to pay fines, he has come up to date with his fines as of today we have provided that proof to Miss McDaniel. The allegation is that he has failed to report as of now. I warned him about it. I told him about his right to a hearing with regard to the violation of probation. He is agreeable to pleading guilty to the violation of probation and being continued on probation which is what the recommendation asks for.

He understands that he needs to be reporting and needs to be paying his fines in a timely manner.


If you complete your probation without any further


