AN ACT to amend "An act concerning the qualifications for the appointment of municipal policemen in certain cases and supplementing Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes," approved (P. L. 1979, c.) (now awaiting action by the Governor as Senate Bill No. 3127 (Official Copy Reprint) of 1979).

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
2 of New Jersey:

1 1. Section 1 of P. L. 1979, c. (C.) is amended to
2 read as follows:

3 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any other law to the con-
4 trary, any former municipal policeman who has separated from
5 service **voluntarily or involuntarily** other than by removal for
6 cause on charges of misconduct or delinquency, shall be deemed to
7 meet the maximum age requirement for appointment established
8 by N. J. S. 40A:14-127, if his actual age, less the number of years
9 of his previous service as a policeman, would meet the maximum
10 age requirement established by said section, *but no person may be*
11-12 *appointed who is over the age of 45 as of the date of his reappoint-*
13 *ment**; *except that in the case of a municipal policeman whose*
14 *separation from service was involuntary due to a lay-off or re-*
15 *duction in force, such person shall be deemed to meet the maximum*
16 *age requirement for appointment by complying with the procedure*
17 *established hereinbefore without regard to his actual age at the*
18 *time of reappointment.**

1 *2. Section 3 of P. L. 1979, c. (C.) is amended
2 to read as follows:

3 3. The Board of Trustees of the Police and Firemen's Retire-
4 ment System of New Jersey shall accept as a member of the retire-
5 ment system any policeman otherwise eligible for membership
6 appointed pursuant to this act, provided that he shall contribute
