INTRODUCED JUNE 26, 1980

By Senators DODD, HAMILTON, WEISS and KENNEDY

AN ACT to transfer the supervisory force of marine patrolmen from the Department of Environmental Protection to the Division of State Police in the Department of Law and Public Safety.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
2 of New Jersey:

1 1. The supervisory force of marine patrolmen, created pursuant
2 to section 17 of the "New Jersey Boat Act of 1962," P. L. 1962,
3 c. 73 (C. 12:7-34.52), hereafter to be known as the State Marine
4 Police Force, with all its powers and duties, is transferred from
5 the Department of Environmental Protection to the Division of
6 State Police in the Department of Law and Public Safety.

7 The transfer directed by this section shall be made in accordance
8 with the "State Agency Transfer Act," P. L. 1971, c. 375
9 (C. 52:14D-1 et seq.).

1 2. This act shall take effect ***[60 days after enactment]*** *July 1,
2 1981.*
