## STATE OF NEW JERSEY

INTRODUCED JANUARY 30, 1978

AN ACT concerning marine patrolmen and the regulation of motor vehicles using \*[frozen inland waterways]\* \*ice-covered waters\*, and supplementing Title 12 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 2 of New Jersey:

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of any \*statute or any\* rule 1 or regulation of the Department of Environmental Protection, the  $\mathbf{2}$ supervisory force of marine patrolmen, created pursuant to section 3 17 of P. L. 1962, c. 73 (C. 12:7-34:52), shall have the same powers 4 conferred upon them, pursuant to R. S. 12:6-6\*,\* with respect to 5motor vehicles operating on \*the\* ice-covered \*[inland water-6 ways]\* \*waters\* of this State as may be provided by law with 7 respect to power and other vessels using such \* inland water-8 ways]\* \*waters\*. 9

2. The Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Protection shall \*have the exclusive authority to\* promulgate rules and regulations pertaining to the seasonal operation of motor vehicles on the frozen\*[inland waterways]\* \*waters\* of this State when such vehicles are used \*[solely for recreational purposes]\* during periods when ice-bound conditions preclude the normal use of such \*[waterways]\* \*waters\* by \*[marine]\* vessels.

1 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

EXPLANATION—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.

## STATE OF NEW JERSEY

#### DATED: DECEMBER 4, 1978

This bill was amended by the committee to provide that it would apply to all frozen waters of this State, not just inland waterways. Thus the department would have authority and enforcement power over waters operating on bays, for example, as well as lakes.

In addition, the Commissioner of the Department of Environmental Protection would have exclusive authority to adopt implementing regulations. The limitation as to recreational purposes is eliminated by the committee and the reference to marine vessels was changed to "vessels" to conform it to the provisions of N. J. S. A. 12:7-34.37(a).
