AN ACT concerning motor vehicles, with respect to reexamination of certain persons as a condition of the continued validity of their driver's license privilege.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. The holder of any motor vehicle driver's license who is
2 involved, within any 6-month period, in two or more **motor vehicle**
3 accidents resulting in **death or in** personal injury or damage to
4 property of any one person in excess of \$200.00 required to be
5 reported to police pursuant to R. S. 39:4-130, **and against whom*
6 *there has been assessed motor vehicle points for each such acci-*
7 *dent,** shall on notice to be given by **[The]* *the** Division of
8 Motor Vehicles, be required to submit to reexamination and suc-
9 cessful passage of an examination of his ability as an operator
10 and a test of his vision, by the Division or by any licensed optome-
11 trist or ophthalmologist.

12 Failure to pass the examination or test required by this act shall
13 be justification for the revocation and refusal to ***[review]***
14 ***renew*** the holder's driver license.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

EXPLANATION—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.

This bill, as amended, requires drivers who are involved in two or more reportable accidents within any 6-month period, and against whom there has been assessed motor vehicle points for each such accident, to submit to a further driver and eye test as a condition for continuation of their driver's license privilege.

The Division of Motor Vehicles supports the bill as amended.

STATE OF NEW JERSEY

DATED: APRIL 26, 1979

This bill, as amended in the Assembly, would require a driver involved in two or more reportable accidents within 6 months, and who was assessed motor vehicle points for both accidents, to submit to a driver and eye test as a condition to continuation of his driver's license privilege. There is a minor amendment which the committee considered in the second paragraph of section 1. From the context of the bill, it was apparent that the word "review" should have read "renew" and the committee so adopted the amendment.
