AN ACT to amend "An act authorizing the Commissioner of Insurance to establish Special Joint Underwriting Associations, prescribing the powers, duties, and functions thereof and supplementing Title 17 of the Revised Statutes," approved September 19, 1974 (P. L. 1974, c. 106).

BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
of New Jersey:

1 1. Section 4 of P. L. 1974, c. 106 (C. 17:30B-4) is amended to 2 read as follows:

3 4. The commissioner shall have authority to establish, as he shall deem necessary, one or more associations to assume the 4 5 unexpired policy obligations of insolvent insurance companies 6 from the date of assumption established by regulation of the com-7 missioner. The membership of each association shall consist of all insurers authorized to write, within this State, on a direct 8 9 basis, the same kind of direct insurance in which the commissioner has authorized participation by the association. Every such insurer 10 11 shall be a member of the association and shall remain a member 12 so long as the association is in existence as a condition of its 13 authority to continue to transact such kinds of insurance in this 14 State. The provision of any other law of this State notwithstand-15 ing, there shall be no liability on the part of and no cause of action 16 of any nature shall arise against any member insurer, the associa-17 tion or its agents or its employees, the board of directors or the 18 commissioner or his representatives for any action taken by them in the performance of their powers and duties under this act*; pro-1920 vided, however, that such immunity from liability shall not extend 21 to such individuals with respect to fraudulent or criminal acts*. 2. This act shall take effect immediately. 1

ASSEMBLY BANKING AND INSURANCE COMMITTEE STATEMENT TO ASSEMBLY, No. 1116 STATE OF NEW JERSEY

DATED: MAY 21, 1979

This legislation, amending the act establishing a special joint underwriting association, provides that members of the joint underwriting associations established to assume the obligations of insolvent insurers and the association itself are not liable for nor can there be any cause of action against them for any action taken by them in the performance of their powers and duties as established by the act.

The Assembly Banking and Insurance Committee has amended this legislation to specifically exclude immunity from fraudulent or criminal acts.
