An Acr to amend the "Public Employees' Retirement System Act," approved June 28, 1954 (P. L. 1954, c. 84) as said short title was amended by P. L. 1971, c. 213.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State

- 1 1. Section 73 of P. L. 1954, c. 84 (C. 43:15A-73) is amended to

- 3 73. a. The Public Employees' Retirement System is hereby

- b. The State University of New Jersey, as an instrumentality

membership, contribution and benefit provisions of the retirement 31

33 Statutes as both are applicable to State employees.

The retirement system shall certify to the Commissioner of In-34

surance and the Commissioner of Insurance shall direct the Com-35 36

pensation Rating and Inspection Bureau to provide the necessary

payments to the retirement system in accordance with procedures 37 38 established by the retirement system. Such payments shall in-

39 clude (1) the contributions and charges, similar to those paid by

other public agency employers, to be paid by the Compensation 40

41 Rating and Inspection Bureau to the retirement system on behalf

42 of its employee members, and (2) the contributions to be paid by

43 the Compensation Rating and Inspection Bureau to provide the

past service credits up to June 30, 1965 for these members, both 44

45 veterans and nonveterans, who enroll before July 1, 1966.

d. The New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority, created 46

and established pursuant to the "New Jersey Sports and Exposi-

tion Authority Law," P. L. 1971, c. 137 (C. 5:10-1 et seq.) shall for 48

all purposes of this act, be deemed an employer and its eligible 49

employees both veterans and nonveterans, shall be subject to the 50

same membership, contribution and benefit provisions of the retire-51

ment system and to the provisions of chapter 3 of Title 43 of the

Revised Statutes as are applicable to State employees. 53

who are not classified as salaried, or who are compensated on an 55

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59 (2) Eligible employees previously permitted to enroll in the re-

tirement system shall redeposit the contributions previously made 60

by them and all service credit shall then be restored and future 61

contributions made at the rate of contribution as originally as-62

signed. The authority shall redeposit the employer payments it 63

had made, with interest to the date of redeposit. 64
