AN ACT concerning county and municipal budgets and authorizing contributions to the National Burn Victim Foundation.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

- 1 1. Any county or municipal governing body may enter a line
2 item in its annual budget for the purpose of making a contribution
3 to the National Burn Victim Foundation which shall be for a public
4 purpose and which will be used to provide the following services
5 to the State of New Jersey:
 - 6 a. Specialized burn treatment facilities and services;
 - 7 b. Burn treatment educational programs for first aid, E. M. S.
8 and other emergency level personnel;
 - 9 c. Burn victim rehabilitation programs, psychological;
 - 10 d. Burn medical research;
 - 11 e. Burn prevention programs for the general public and civic
12 organizations.
- 1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
