- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
- 2 of New Jersey:
- 1 1. R. S. 19:23-45 is amended to read as follows:
- 2 19:23-45. No voter shall be allowed to vote at the primary elec-
- 3 tion unless his name appears in the signature copy register.
- 4 A voter who votes in a primary election of a political party or
- 5 who signs and files with the municipal clerk or the county com-
- 6 missioner of registration a declaration that he desires to vote in
