An Act preserving Island Beach State Park in its present state for posterity.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State

- 1. The Legislature hereby declares that Island Beach State Park
- 2 is one of the few natural expanses of barrier beach remaining along
- 3 the eastern edge of North America; that Island Beach State Park
- 4 is highly valued for its topography, flora and fauna; that Island
