PRE-FILED FOR INTRODUCTION IN THE 1976 SESSION

By Senator RUSSO

AN ACT preserving Island Beach State Park in its present state
for posterity.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. The Legislature hereby declares that Island Beach State Park
2 is one of the few natural expanses of barrier beach remaining along
3 the eastern edge of North America; that Island Beach State Park
4 is highly valued for its topography, flora and fauna; that Island
5 Beach State Park serves the citizens of this State as a unique
6 recreational and educational resource and that therefore Island
7 Beach State Park shall be preserved, maintained and improved in
8 such a manner as the Division of Parks and Forestry in the Depart-
9 ment of Environmental Protection determines will best perpetuate
10 the park's present physical state.

1 2. Island Beach State Park shall from this day forward be
2 preserved for posterity in accordance with the terms of this act.

Governor Brendan Byrne has signed S-878 into law. The bill, sponsored by Senator John F. Russo, D-Ocean, provides for the preservation, maintenance and improvement of Island Beach State Park.

The bill was unanimously passed by the Senate last year and unanimously approved by the Assembly last month.
