An Act concerning the appointment of county administrators and amending N. J. S. 40A:9-1.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
- 2 of New Jersey:
- 1 1. N. J. S. 40A:9-1 is amended to read as follows:
- 2 40A:9-1. Except in the case of county administrator, counsel,
- 3 attorney, engineer, health officer, auditor, comptroller, appointed
- 4 tax collector, elected assessors who have received tenure under P. L.
- 5 1967, c. 44, s. 7 (C. 54:1-35.31), appointed tax assessor, or members
- 6 of boards of assessors or as otherwise provided by law, every
- 7 person holding an office, the authority and duties of which relate
- 8 to a county only, or to a municipality only, shall reside within said
- 9 county or municipality, as the case may be.
- 10 Any person holding or attempting to hold any such office in a
- 11 county or municipality in violation hereof, may be ousted in a
- 12 proceeding in lieu of prerogative writ.
- 1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT
