Governor Brendan Byrne today signed into law the following bills:

A-2160 OCR, sponsored by Assemblyman William J. Hamilton, Jr., (D-Middlesex) will exclude property which is intended for the construction of Route 18 in Middlesex County from the review jurisdiction of the Delaware and Raritan Canal Commission.

The section of the lands adjacent to the Canal are evidently not required for the first stage of construction from Albany Street to Hamilton Street. They would be required, however, for the second stage of construction involving the extension of the highway across the Raritan River into New Erunswick.

S-3169, sponsored by Senator Bernard Dwyer, (D-Middlesex) which adds the position of County Administrator to the list of those exempted from municipal and county residency requirements.

Prior to this, the law exempted the following positions:

counsel, attorney, engineer, health officer, auditor, comptroller,

appointed tax collector, tenural elected assessors, appointed tax

assessors and members of boards of assessors.

The bills were signed at the Middlesex County Administration Building in New Brunswick.
