3 *and* expend **[a sum not in excess of \$3,000.00]** in any 1 year, for  
4 membership in *and the services of* **[any association composed ex-**  
5 **clusively of boards of chosen freeholders]** *the New Jersey Associa-*  
6 *tion of Counties, such sums as said board may determine.*

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

### STATEMENT

This bill removes the current statutory limitations on the maximum amount that a board of chosen freeholders may contribute to an association of counties. Increased member contributions are essential for the expansion and upgrading of the services provided by the county association. In addition the phrase "composed exclusively of boards of chosen freeholders" is deleted in recognition of the impending broadening of the membership base and redesignation of the association as the New Jersey Association of Counties.
