AN ACT to amend the "county improvement authorities law,"
approved January 18, 1961 (P. L. 1960, c. 183).

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Section 47 of P. L. 1960, c. 183 (C. 40:37A-90) is amended to
2 read as follows:

3 47. This act shall be construed liberally to effectuate the legis-
4 lative intent and as complete and independent authority for the
5 performance of each and every act and thing herein authorized, and
6 an authority shall not constitute or be deemed to be a county or
7 municipality or agency or component of a municipality for the
8 purposes of any other law; provided, however, that no authority,
9 other than an authority created in a county of the second class
10 having a population in excess of 265,000, but less than 350,000 in-
11 habitants, *in a county of the third class having a population not*
12 *in excess of 65,000 inhabitants*, or in a county of the fifth class hav-
13 ing a population in excess of 150,000, but less than 300,000 in-
14 habitants, shall exercise the powers of a common carrier, and,
15 except as hereinabove in this section set forth, nothing contained
16 in this act shall in any way affect or limit the jurisdiction, rights,
17 powers or duties of any State regulatory agencies.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

Governor Brendan Byrne signed a bill Thursday which will allow the Salem County Improvement Authority to operate a bus service.

The bill, S-3101, was sponsored by State Senator Raymond Zane, D-Salem.

The Salem County Improvement Authority has already acquired the buses for the service, but due to a technicality in Title 40 of the state statute, it was not allowed to operate a common carrier service.

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
