STATEMENT

The Director of the Division of Budget and Accounting is presently required to prepare and distribute monthly fiscal reports. The present monthly report is prepared manually and is not available until approximately 60 days after the close of the accounting period, precluding use of the monthly report as a management tool. Agencies do, however, receive weekly and monthly computerized reports indicating the status of their appropriations and complete details of all financial transactions. Management decisions can be, and are, based on these reports. The monthly reports, therefore, no longer serve the purpose for which they were originally intended when mandated in 1944.

This legislation provides that the Director of the Division of Budget and Accounting prepare semiannual reports, at the end of the fiscal and calendar years. This change more closely parallels modern practice in most private, industrial and commercial organizations which normally publish only annual reports.

This bill amends existing law by requiring that fiscal reports be prepared semi-annually rather than monthly. The two reports would have to be prepared no later than 60 days following December 31, and 90 days following the last day in which annual appropriations are available for expenditure during each fiscal year.

It is further stated that the Director of the Division of Budget and Accounting shall prepare monthly summaries no later than 30 days following the end of each month.

Governor Brendan Byrne today signed into law the following bills:

S-865 sponsored by Senator Alfred N. Beadleston, D-Monmouth, which requires deeds which transfer real property to include the lot and block number or the account number of that property.

The bill is intended to provide continuity of the property inventory kept by the municipal tax assessor.

<u>S-1338</u> sponsored by Senator Joseph P. Merlino, D-Mercer, which requires the Director of the Division of Budgeting and Accounting to prepare semi-annual reports and summarized monthly reports.

Prior to this legislation, the Director of the Division was required to prepare and distribute monthly fiscal reports. The monthly reports were prepared manually and were not available until approximately 60 days after the close of the accounting period. This limited their use as a management tool.

<u>S-1670</u> sponsored by Senator Anne C. Martindell, D-Mercer, which updates and revises the law relating to the keeping of bees and the control of bee diseases.

This increases the level of fines for violations of the law and establishes a procedure for the disposition of abandoned beehives.

A-1878 sponsored by Assemblyman Michael F. Adubato, D-Essex, which allows certain people in the classified civil service to receive a promotion while on a leave of absence to fill an elective public office.

The bill allows any county, municipal or school district civil service employee who is given a leave of absence to fill an elective public office to:

(1) take a promotional appointment if he had taken an exam prior to taking the leave of absence and is on the eligible list; and (2) to receive and accept a promotion while on leave and return to employment in his promoted capacity as long as he completes a working test period in his new position.
