A SUPPLEMENT to "An act providing for leave of absence to persons holding office, position or employment, other than for a fixed term or period, in the classified service of any county, municipality or school district in certain cases," passed June 16, 1942 (P. L. 1942, c. 253, C. 11:24A-7).

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
- 2 of New Jersey:
- 1. Notwithstanding any law, rule or regulation to the contrary,
- 2 a leave of absence granted pursuant to P. L. 1942, c. 253
- 3 (C. 11:24A-7) shall not disqualify an applicant *[for]* **[*from
- 4 taking* any promotion examination *[if such applicant is other-
- 5 wise ** *for which otherwise * qualified *or from any promotion
- 6 resulting therefrom provided that such applicant shall meet all of
- 7 the requirements of such examination prior to the taking of such
- 8 leave of absence******** ***for a promotional appointment if such
- 9 applicant has taken a promotional examination prior to the grant-
- 10 ing of the leave of absence to fill an elective office and subsequently
- appears on an eligible list resulting from said promotional examination and is appointed therefrom prior to the expiration of said list**.

Under this bill, any person who holds an office, position, or employment, other than for a fixed term or period, in the classified service of any county, municipality, or school district operating under the Civil Service statutes and who is elected to public office is permitted to take a promotional examination and to receive a promotion while on leave of absence to fill the elective public office. Such a person would return to his office, position, or employment in his promoted capacity after the completion of his elective term.
