#### STATEMENT

This bill permits certain public employees to accept an elected public office after retirement on pension; it is in accordance with Governor Byrne's recent comments on the subject when he was questioned about his pocket veto of Senate Bill No. 3272 of 1975—which would have allowed public employees to accept other public employment after retirement on pension. Governor Byrne expressed a desire that such legislation be limited to permitting retired public employees to run for and hold elected public office.

This bill supplements Title 43 of the Revised Statutes to permit certain members of retirement systems established under the laws of the State to keep their pension or retirement allowance and serve as elected public officers.

The bill will mainly effect municipal governments and has the strong support of the League of Municipalities.
