AN ACT concerning alcoholic beverage control and supplementing
Title 33 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. No Class C license, as the same is defined in R. S. 33:1-12,
2 shall be renewed if the same has not been actively used in connec-
3 tion with the operation of a licensed premises within a period of 2
4 years prior to the commencement date of the license period for
5 which the renewal application is filed unless the director, for good
6 cause and after a hearing, authorizes a further application for
7 renewal; provided, however that, if the licensee has been deprived
8 of the use of the licensed premises as a result of eminent domain
9 fire or other casualty, and establishes by affidavit filed with the
10 director that he is making a good faith effort to resume active use
11 of the license in connection with the operation of a licensed premise
12 then the period of 2 years provided for in this section shall be
13 automatically extended for an additional period of 2 years.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATE OF NEW JERSEY

DATED: JUNE 10, 1976

This legislation would prohibit the renewal of a Class C liquor license in the event that such license has not been actively used in connection with the operation of a licensed premises within a period of 2 years prior to the commencement date of the license period for which the renewal is filed, unless such renewal is authorized by the Director of the Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control. The prohibition against renewal would not apply in the event that the licensee has been deprived of the use of the licensed premises as a result of eminent domain, fire, or other casualty, and this fact is established by affidavit of the licensee; in such case, the license would be automatically extended for an additional 2 years.

STATE OF NEW JERSEY

DATED: NOVEMBER 8, 1976

The purpose of this bill is to provide for the retirement of unused class C alcoholic beverage licenses by prohibiting their renewal if they are not actively used for 2 years preceding the renewal date. That period may be extended for another 2 years if the license is not actively used because of eminent domain proceedings, fire or other casualty regarding the licensed premises and the licensee demonstrates by affidavit, a good faith effort to resume active use.
