AN ACT concerning certain employees appointed to office, position or employment by county park commissions in certain cases and supplementing subdivision C of article 5 of chapter 37 of Title 40 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Any full-time employee appointed to office, position or em-
2 ployment*, *pursuant to the provisions of R. S. 40:37-148,** by a
3 county park commission in any county of the second class having a
4 population of more than 460,000 and less than 525,000 ***[pursuant**
5 **to the provisions of R. S. 40:37-148]*** **according to the 1970*
6 *Federal census** shall secure tenure of office after serving three
7 successive 1-year appointments. Such employee shall hold and
8 continue to hold said office, position or employment during good
9 behavior and shall not be removed therefrom except for good cause,
10 upon written charges and after a public, fair and impartial hearing
11 before the commission.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATE OF NEW JERSEY

DATED: FEBRUARY 17, 1977

Assembly Bill No. 1467 grants tenure to certain full-time employees of a county park commission, appointed pursuant to R. S. 40:37-148. The provisions of the bill apply only to employees who have served or shall serve in an office, position or employment with such commission for three successive 1-year terms. The bill affects only counties with a population of between 460,000 and 525,000, that is, Passaic county.

The Senate committee amendments will assure that the provisions of the bill will continue to apply to Passaic county even if, at a later date, the population of the county should exceed or fall below the statutory limits set forth in the bill.
