An Act concerning marriages and supplementing chapter 1 of Title 37 of the Revised Statutes.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
- 2 of New Jersey:
- 1 1. A licensing officer or other person issuing marriage licenses
- 2 shall make information available to applicants concerning places
- 3 where such applicants may be tested for genetic diseases including,
- 4 but not limited to Cooley's Anemia, Sickle Cell Anemia, and Tay-
- 5 Sachs Disease. Literature containing such information which has
- 6 been prepared and provided by private organizations may be dis-
- 7 tributed to applicants by a licensing officer or other person issuing
- 8 marriage licenses.
- 1 2. This act shall take effect on the ninetieth day after enactment.

STATEMENT

The purpose of this bill is to require city clerks and registrars of vital statistics to make available information in their offices which indicates where persons applying for marriage licenses may be tested for genetic diseases, and to permit city clerks and registrars of vital statistics to distribute literature concerning same which has been prepared and provided by private organizations.

This bill requires persons issuing marriage licenses to provide applicants with information regarding testing for genetic diseases, such as Cooley's Anemia, Sickle Cell Anemia and Tay-Sachs Disease and permits such persons to distribute literature prepared by private organizations interested in genetic screening.

The committee agreed with the intent of the bill and reported it without amendment.
