STATE OF NEW JERSEY

DATED: DECEMBER 1, 1977

This bill provides a salary increase for the director and judges of the Division of Workers' Compensation.

The committee amended the bill to require that a judge of compensation receive a favorable evaluation from the Director of Compensation, based on recommendations of a supervising Judge, before said judge could receive an annual increment.

The committee also amended the bill to require that a judge of compensation be an attorney for 10 years prior to appointment and that the director of the Division of Workers' Compensation have the same qualifications for appointment as a judge of compensation.

Amend page 1, section 1, line 23, after ".", insert "No subsequent annual increment for a judge of compensation shall be made unless the judge of compensation is evaluated favorably by the director of the division on the basis of recommendations made by the supervising judge of compensation.".

Amend page 1, section 1, line 24, omit "and", insert ",".

Amend page 1, section 1, line 25, after "duties", insert ", and shall have been licensed attorneys for 10 years prior to their appointments. The director of the division shall have the same qualifications for appointment as a judge of compensation".
