# STATE OF NEW JERSEY

INTRODUCED DECEMBER 1, 1977

By Senator FELDMAN

(Without Reference)

AN ACT to amend "An act fixing the annual compensation of members of the Senate and General Assembly and providing for the payment thereof and for the payment of an additional allowance to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the General Assembly," approved April 9, 1948 (P. L. 1948, c. 16).

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Section 1 of P. L. 1948, c. 16 (C. 52:10A-1) is amended to  
2 read as follows:

3 1. Members of the Senate and General Assembly shall receive  
4 annually, during the term for which they shall have been elected  
5 and while they shall hold their office, compensation in the sum of  
6 **[\$7,500.00]** \$10,000.00 each, until the beginning of the legislative  
7 year following the next general election for members of the General  
8 Assembly and thereafter and beginning with said legislative year  
9 they shall receive annually during the term for which they shall  
10 have been elected and while they shall hold their office, compensa-  
11 tion in the sum of **[\$10,000.00]** \$18,000.00 each. The President of  
12 the Senate and the Speaker of the General Assembly, each by  
13 virtue of his office, shall receive an additional allowance, equal to  
14  $\frac{1}{3}$  of his compensation as a member. The compensation herein  
15 provided shall be paid to each member upon his qualifying into  
16 office as such member, and the additional allowance herein provided  
17 to the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the General  
18 Assembly shall be paid upon his qualifying into office as such officer.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.
