INTRODUCED MAY 10, 1977

By Senators WILEY and DUMONT

Referred to Committee on Education

AN ACT concerning education and amending N. J. S. 18A:4-32*, *
[and] N. J. S. 18A:4-34 *and P. L. 1969, c. 158*.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. N. J. S. 18A:4-32 is amended to read as follows:

2 18A:4-32. Assistant commissioners; appointment; compensation.
3 The commissioner, subject to the approval of the State board, shall
4 appoint not more than **[six]** *seven* assistant commisioners of edu-
5 cation, and fix their compensation, and he shall from time to time
6 designate one of them to act in his place and stead during his
7 absence.

1 2. N. J. S. 18A:4-34 is amended to read as follows:

2 18A:4-34. Duties of assistant commissioners. Each assistant
3 commissioner shall perform such duties in the public school system
4 of the State as may from time to time be assigned to him by the
5 commissioner, which shall include, but need not be limited to, any
6 one or more of the following:

- 7 a. The supervision of curriculum and instruction;
- 8 b. The supervision of vocational education;
- 9 c. The hearing and determination of controversies and disputes
- 10 which may arise under the school laws, or the rules of the State
- 11 board, or of the commissioner; **[and]**
- 12 d. The supervision of business and financial matters**[.]**; *and*
- 13 *e. The supervision of the Division of the State Library, Archives*
- 14 *and History****[.]** *including duties and responsibilities of the director*
- 15 *of said division notwithstanding the provisions of any other law**.

1 *3. Section 12 of P. L. 1969, c. 158 (C. 18A:73-27) is amended to
2 read as follows:

**EXPLANATION—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill
is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.**

3 18A:73-27. The division shall consist of *an assistant commis-*
4 *sioner* **[a director]** and an advisory council and such other per-
5 sonnel as the Commissioner of Education may deem necessary for
6 the efficient administration thereof.

1 4. Section 17 of P. L. 1969, c. 158 (C. 18A:73-32) is amended to
2 read as follows:

3 18A:73-32. The *assistant commissioner for* **[director of]** the
4 division shall be the State Librarian. **[The Commissioner of**
5 **Education, subject to the approval of the State Board of Educa-**
6 **tion, shall appoint the State Librarian and fix his compensation,**
7 **subject to the provisions of Title 11, Civil Service of the Revised**
8 **Statutes.]**

9 The *assistant commissioner* **[State Librarian]** shall be a gradu-
10 ate of an accredited university or college and shall, prior to his
11 appointment, have graduated from a school of library service
12 accredited by the American Library Association, and have had at
13 least 4 years of library experience in a responsible administrative
14 capacity.*

1 ***[3.]*** *5.* This act shall take effect immediately.
