PRE-FILED FOR INTRODUCTION IN THE 1976 SESSION

By Assemblymen JACKMAN and T. GALLO

AN ACT concerning leaves of absence of certain public employees to attend State or National conventions and supplementing Title 40A of the New Jersey Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. The heads of the county offices of the several counties and
2 the head of every department, bureau and office in the government
3 of the various municipalities, shall give a leave of absence with
4 pay to every person in the service of the county or municipality
5 who is a duly authorized representative of the New Jersey State
6 Patrolmen's Benevolent Association, Inc., Fraternal Order of
7 Police, Firemen's Mutual Benevolent Association, Inc., the
8 Uniformed Firemen's Association, or the New Jersey State
9 Association of Chiefs of Police, to attend any State or National
10 convention of such organization.

11 A certificate of attendance to the State convention shall, upon
12 request, be submitted by the representative so attending.

13 Leave of absence shall be for a period inclusive of the duration
14 of the convention with a reasonable time allowed for time to travel
15 to and from the convention.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT
