L. 1975, c. 354), so that the same shall read, "An act authorizing the State to lease riparian lands to municipalities and counties *and other instrumentalities of the State* in certain cases," and to amend the body of said act.

- 1 1. The title of P. L. 1975, c. 354 is amended to read as follows:

- 2. Section 1 of P. L. 1975, c. 354 (C. 12:3-37.1) is amended to
- 2 read as follows:
- 3 1. The State is authorized to lease or otherwise permit [the]
- 4 county or municipal *or other instrumentality of the State* use of
- 5 riparian lands owned by the State and situate within the county
- 6 *or other instrumentality of the State* or within or contiguous
- 7 to said municipality, when said lease or use is approved by the
- 8 Department of Environmental Protection, without consideration
- 9 or at nominal consideration, and to be maintained and used ex-
- 10 clusively for park and recreational purposes. Said lease or use
- 11 agreement shall contain a limitation that if the riparian lands are
- 12 not maintained and used in accordance with the provisions of this

STATE OF NEW JERSEY

DATED: APRIL 21, 1977

Senate Bill No. 1497 would permit the State to lease State-owned riparian lands to counties for recreational purposes. Present law restricts such agreements to municipalities.

The Assembly committee amendments would further extend such agreements to include "other instrumentalities of the State."
