AN ACT to amend "An act concerning motor vehicles, and supplementing chapter 3 of Title 39 of the Revised Statutes," passed June 17, 1968 (P. L. 1968, c. 247).

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Section 1 of P. L. 1968, c. 247 (C. 39:3-27.5) is amended to read  
2 as follows:

3 1. The Director of the Division of Motor Vehicles shall cause to  
4 be issued to **[each applicant]** *applicants* who **[holds an]** *hold*  
5 amateur radio **[license]** *licenses* issued by the Federal Communica-  
6 tions Commission, registration plates for **[one]** motor **[vehicle]**  
7 *vehicles* bearing the amateur radio call letters of **[such applicant]**  
8 *the respective applicants. Where such call letters consist of less*  
9 *than six letters, the director, upon request, shall cause to be issued*  
10 *duplicate plates, with such marks as the director may deem appro-*  
11 *priate to distinguish them from the original plates, for any addi-*  
12 *tional motor vehicle which an applicant may register.*

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

This bill would authorize the issuance of duplicate motor vehicle registration plates for additional vehicles owned by registrants who are amateur radio licensees and who presently have plates consisting of their call letters.

This bill would authorize the Director of the Division of Motor Vehicles to issue duplicate motor vehicle registration plates for additional vehicles owned by registrants who are amateur radio licensees and who have plates issued to them consisting of their call letters.

The plates may be issued to persons having call letters consisting of fewer than 6 letters and the director is authorized to include marks to distinguish them from the originals.
