## INTRODUCED FEBRUARY 7, 1977

An Act to amend "An act concerning motor vehicles, and supplementing chapter 3 of Title 39 of the Revised Statutes," passed June 17, 1968 (P. L. 1968, c. 247).

Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey:

1. Section 1 of P. L. 1968, c. 247 (C. $39: 3-27.5$ ) is amended to read as follows:
2. The Director of the Division of Motor Vehicles shall cause to be issued to [each applicant] applicants who [holds an] hold amateur radio 【license】 licenses issued by the Federal Communications Commission, registration plates for [one] motor [vehicle] vehicles bearing the amateur radio call letters of [such applicant] the respective applicants. Where such call letters consist of less than six letters, the director, upon request, shall cause to be issued duplioate plates, with such marks as the director may deem appropriate to distinguish them from the original plates, for any additional motor vehicle which an applicant may register.
3. This act shall take effect immediately.

## STATEMENT

This bill would authorize the issuance of duplicate motor vehicle registration plates for additional vehicles owned by registrants who are amateur radio licensees and who presently have plates consisting of their call letters.

## STATE OF NEW JERSEY

DATED: MARCH 21, 1977
This bill would authorize the Director of the Division of Motor Vehicles to issue duplicate motor vehicle registration plates for additional vehicles owned by registrants who are amateur radio licensees and who have plates issued to them consisting of their call letters.

The plates may be issued to persons having call letters consisting of fewer than 6 letters and the director is authorized to include marks to distinguish them from the originals.
