An Act concerning elections and amending R. S. 19:14-12.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
- 2 of New Jersey:

- 1 1. R. S. 19:14-12 is amended to read as follows:
  - 19:14-12. The county clerk shall draw lots in his county to
- 3 determine which columns the political parties which made nomina-
- 4 tions at the next preceding primary election shall occupy on the
- 5 ballot in the county. The name of the party first drawn shall
- 6 occupy the first column at the left of the ballot, and the name of
- 7 the party next drawn shall occupy the second column, and so forth.
- 8 The position which the names of candidates, and bracketed
- 9 groups of names of candidates nominated by petitions for all offices,
- 10 shall have upon the general election ballot, shall be determined by
- 11 the county clerks in their respective counties.
- 12 The manner of drawing the lots shall be as follows: paper slips
- 13 with the names of each political party written thereon, shall be
- 14 placed in capsules of the same size, shape, color and substance and
- 15 then placed in a covered box with an aperture in the top large
- 16 enough to admit a man's hand and to allow the capsules to be
- 17 drawn therefrom. The box shall be well shaken and turned over
- 18 to thoroughly intermingle the capsules. The county clerk or his
- 19 deputy shall at his office, draw from the box each capsule separately
- 20 without knowledge on his part as to which capsule he is drawing.
- 21 The person making the drawing shall open the capsule and shall
- 22 make public announcement at the drawing of each name, the order
- 23 in which name is drawn and the office for which the drawing is made.
- 24 Where there is but one person to be elected to an office, the
- 25 names of the several candidates who have filed petitions for such
- 26 office shall be written upon paper slips and placed in separate

- 27 capsules of the same size, shape, color and substance. The cap-
- 28 sules shall be placed in a covered box with an aperture in the top
- 29 large enough to admit a man's hand and to allow the capsules to
- 30 be drawn therefrom. The box shall be turned and shaken thor-
- 31 oughly to mix the capsules and the capsules shall be withdrawn
- 32 one at a time.
- 33 When there is more than one person to be elected to an office
- 34 where petitions have designated that crtain candidates shall be
- 35 bracketed, the position of such bracketed names on the ballot (each
- 36 bracketed group to be treated as a single name), together with in-
- 37 dividuals who have filed petitions for such office, shall be determined
- 38 as above described.
- 39 Any legal voter of the county or municipality, as the case may
- 40 be, shall have the privilege of witnessing the drawing.
- 41 The name or names of the candidate or bracketed group of
- 42 candidates first drawn from the box shall be printed directly below
- 43 the proper title of the office for which they were nominated, and
- 44 the name or names of the candidate or bracketed group of candi-
- 45 dates next drawn shall be printed next in order, and so on, until
- 46 the last name or bracketed group of names shall be drawn from
- 47 the box.
- 48 The arrangement of names of any bracketed group of candidates
- 49 for any office for which more than one are to be elected shall be
- 50 printed in the same order on the ballot as they were arranged on
- 51 the petition of nomination.
- 52 The drawing for the positions which the names of candidates
- 53 and bracketed groups of names of caudidates, nominated by petition
- 54 for office, and for the columns which the political parties which
- 55 made nominations at the next preceding primary election shall
- 56 occupy upon the general election ballot, shall be held at 3 o'clock
- 57 in the afternoon of the [fiftieth] eighty-fifth day prior to the day

- \*2. Section 19:13-22 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read
- 2 as follows:
- 3 19:13-22. The Secretary of State, not later than [fifty-one]
- 4 eighty-six days before any election whereat any candidates nomi-
- 5 nated in any direct petition or primary certificate of nomination or
- 6 State convention certificate filed with him are to be voted for, shall
- 7 make and certify, under his hand and seal of office, and forward to
- 8 the clerks of the several counties of the State a statement of all
- 9 such candidates for whom the voters within such county may be
- 10 by law entitled to vote at such election. This statement, in addition

- 11 to the names of the candidates for President and Vice-President of
- 12 the United States, if any such have been included in any such
- 13 certificate or petition filed with him, shall contain the names and
- 14 residences of all other candidates, the offices for which they are
- 15 respectively nominated, and the names of the parties by which or
- 16 the political appellation under which they are respectively nomi-
- 17 nated. Candidates nominated directly by petition, without dis-
- 18 tinctive political appellation, shall be certified as independent candi-
- 19 dates. Similar statements shall be made, certified and forwarded,
- 20 when vacancies are filled subsequently, according to law.\*
- 1 \*[2.]\* \*3.\* This act shall take effect immediately.
