PRE-FILED FOR INTRODUCTION IN THE 1976 SESSION

By Senator BEADLESTON

AN ACT relating to maritime liens, and amending N. J. S. 2A:44-59.

1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State

2 of New Jersey:

1 1. N. J. S. 2A:44-59 is amended to read as follows:

2 2A:44–59. A debt contracted by an owner of a vessel within

3 this State, shall be a continuing lien upon the vessel and her apparel4 until paid, for:

a. Labor performed or materials or articles furnished in this
State for the building, repairing, fitting, furnishing or equipping
the vessel in this State at the time when the same was performed
or were furnished; or

9 b. Supplies, provisions and stores furnished within this State10 for the use of the vessel; or

11 c. Towing [and], wharfage and drydockage of the vessel and

12 the expenses of keeping the same in storage in port in water or on

13 land, including expenses incurred in taking care of and employing14 persons to watch the vessel.

15 The lien shall be preferred to all other liens on the vessel, except 16 mariner's wages.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

This bill would extend the maritime lien law to charges incurred for drydockage and storage of vessels on land or in the water.

EXPLANATION—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.

This bill would extend the maritime lien law to include charges incurred for drydockage and storage of vessels on land or in the water. At present, maritime liens extend to charges incurred for labor and material costs for work performed on vessels, for supplies and provisions used on the vessel, and towage, wharfage and "the expenses of keeping the same in port." This legislation amends subsection C. of N. J. S. 2A:44-59 to define such expenses more clearly.

STATEMENT TO SENATE, No. 871

STATE OF NEW JERSEY

DATED: FEBRUARY 9, 1976

Senate Bill No. 871 concerns the placing of liens on a sea vessel and her apparel, for debts contracted by the owner of the vessel for goods or services rendered within the State to such vessel. This bill would extend the definition of services for which a lien can be attached so as to include the drydockage of any such vessel and the expenses of keeping vessel in storage, whether on water or land.
