AN ACT concerning pension funds of employees of counties of the first class having a population of less than 800,000, and supplementing article 1 of chapter 10 of Title 43 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Any employee, who at the time of his entry into a county
2 pension fund established pursuant to article 1 of chapter 10 of
3 Title 43 of the Revised Statutes, was given credit for and paid
4 contributions to the fund for a period of service as an employee
5 ***[in any other state, county or municipal position]*** *of the State*
6 *of New Jersey or of any municipality or agency, commission or*
7 *board thereof in a county adopting the provisions of article 1 of*
8 *chapter 10 of Title 43 of the Revised Statutes**, shall be entitled
9 to credit for the period of other governmental service just as if
10 that period had been spent in the employment of the county, and
11 the actions of the county pension commission in granting credit
12 for such periods of other governmental service are hereby ratified,
13 validated and confirmed.

1 2. Any employee, who has heretofore withdrawn his contribu-
2 tions, pursuant to R. S. 43:10-8, from a county pension fund
3 established pursuant to article 1 of chapter 10 of Title 43 of the
4 Revised Statutes, and has thereafter reentered the fund and paid
5 contributions to the fund, shall be entitled to pension credit for
6 the entire period for which contributions have been paid into the
7 fund, and the actions of the county pension commission in granting
8 such pension credit to any employee so reentering the fund are
9 hereby ratified, validated and confirmed.

1 3. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

This bill would authorize and validate the granting of pension credit by the Hudson County Pension Committee to employees for other governmental service and to employees reentering the pension fund.

STATE OF NEW JERSEY

DATED: JUNE 3, 1976

Assembly Bill No. 1529 authorizes and validates actions taken by the Hudson county pension committee regarding:

(1) The grant of service credits to any county employee for employment in any other state, county or municipal position, if such county employee established such service credits at the time of entry into the county pension fund;

(2) The repurchase of credit time for past county service on which contributions had earlier been withdrawn pursuant to R. S. 43:10-8; credit shall be given for the entire time for which the employee made contributions after reentry into the fund.
