#### STATEMENT

The purpose of this bill is to effectively halt the illegal sale of striped bass less than 18 inches long in the State. Although such a law exists, food wholesalers have found a way around it by cutting off the heads and tails before offering them for sale, so that there is no way of measuring the fish. This bill would ban the removal of heads or tails of striped bass before they are offered for sale. The possession of any striped bass or parts thereof from which the head or tail has been removed other than while in preparation, or being served, as food shall be presumed to be possession for sale in violation of this provision. Any person violating the provisions of this act shall be subject to the penalty provisions of P. L. 1938, c. 318, as amended (C. 23:5–5.8) \$20.00 for each fish so unlawfully taken, caught, killed, possessed or sold.
