- AN ACT to amend "An act authorizing municipalities to acquire and retire alcoholic beverage retail consumption licenses in certain cases and to borrow money and increase annual license fees for retail consumption licenses to assist in financing acquisition of such licenses," approved September 4, 1968 (P. L. 1968, c. 277).
- 1 BE IT ENACTED by the Senate and General Assembly of the State 2 of New Jersey:
- 1 1. Section 5 of P. L. 1968, c. 277 (C. 40:48-2.44) is amended to 2 read as follows:
- 5. No contract for acquisition of a license, authorized by an
 ordinance adopted pursuant to this act, may be entered into after
 [January 1, 1977] January 1, 1982.
- 1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

This bill extends from January 1, 1977 to January 1, 1982, the expiration date for the retirement of surplus alcoholic beverage licenses in certain municipalities.
