AN ACT to amend "An act authorizing municipalities to acquire and retire alcoholic beverage retail consumption licenses in certain cases and to borrow money and increase annual license fees for retail consumption licenses to assist in financing acquisition of such licenses," approved September 4, 1968 (P. L. 1968, c. 277).

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Section 5 of P. L. 1968, c. 277 (C. 40:48-2.44) is amended to
2 read as follows:

3 5. No contract for acquisition of a license, authorized by an
4 ordinance adopted pursuant to this act, may be entered into after
5 **[January 1, 1977]** *January 1, 1982.*

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

This bill extends from January 1, 1977 to January 1, 1982, the expiration date for the retirement of surplus alcoholic beverage licenses in certain municipalities.

EXPLANATION—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.

DATED: MAY 27, 1976

This legislation extends the expiration date of the program established by P. L. 1968, c. 277 from January 1, 1977 to January 1, 1982. This program authorizes municipalities to acquire and retire surplus alcoholic beverage licenses.

P. L. 1968, c. 277 established a program authorizing certain municipalities to adopt ordinances through which they could acquire and retire surplus alcoholic beverage licenses. This bill would simply extend that program from January 1, 1977 to January 1, 1982.
