# STATE OF NEW JERSEY

INTRODUCED NOVEMBER 18, 1974

AN ACT to amend "An act concerning certain deductions from the compensation of persons holding public office, position or employment, whose compensation is paid by this State or any county, municipality, school district or other political subdivision of this State, or by any board, body, agency, or commission thereof," approved May 12, 1947 (P. L. 1946, c. 7).

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Section 1 of P. L. 1946, c. 7 (C. 52:14-15.9a.) is amended to  
2 read as follows:

3 1. Whenever any person holding public office, position or employ-  
4 ment, whose compensation is paid by this State or any county,  
5 municipality, school district or other political subdivision of this  
6 State, or by any board, body, agency or commission thereof,  
7 shall indicate in writing to the proper disbursing officer his desire  
8 to have any deduction made from his compensation for the payment  
9 of insurance premiums written on the group plan of accident and  
10 sickness insurance, *or property or liability insurance*, or for any  
11 hospital service plan and medical-surgical plan, such disbursing  
12 officer shall, except in counties of the first class, make such deduc-  
13 tion from the compensation of such person, and such disbursing  
14 officer shall transmit the sum so deducted to the company carrying  
15 such insurance. In counties of the first class, such disbursing officer  
16 shall make such deduction from the compensation of such person  
17 and shall transmit the sum so deducted to the company carrying  
18 such insurance only when directed so to do by the board of chosen  
19 freeholders.

20 Any such written authorization may be withdrawn by such per-  
21 son holding public office, position or employment at any time  
22 upon filing notice of such withdrawal with the above mentioned  
23 disbursing officer.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

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STATEMENT

Article XXVIII of the recently executed Collective Negotiations Agreement between the State of New Jersey and the New Jersey Civil Service Association and the New Jersey State Employees Association for the State Administrative and Clerical Services Unit contains a commitment that the State will establish a program affording employees an opportunity to voluntarily purchase various insurance policies on a group participation basis. The policy costs are to be borne entirely by the employees. However, the State is committed to provide a payroll deduction procedure whereby authorized moneys may be withheld from earned salaries of such employees and remitted to the insurance company. This bill provides the necessary statutory authority for implementing such a payroll deduction procedure.
