## STATE OF NEW JERSEY

### PRE-FILED FOR INTRODUCTION IN THE 1974 SESSION

### By Senator DAVENPORT

An Act concerning the Passaic Valley Sewerage District and amending R. S. 58:14-25.

- 1 Be it enacted by the Senate and General Assembly of the State
- 2 of New Jersey:
- 1 1. R. S. 58:14-25 is amended to read as follows:
- 2 58:14-25. At any time after the making of a contract in accord-
- 3 ance with the provisions of this chapter, the commissioners may,
- 4 with the consent of each of the municipalities which have contracted
- 5 with them, evidenced by resolution of the body or board having
- 6 charge of its sewer system or authorized to construct sewers
- 7 therein, enter into a contract with any municipality lying in whole
- 8 or in part within the drainage area of the Passaic river between
- 9 the Great falls at the city of Paterson and Newark bay, and in-
- 10 cluding the boroughs of Totowa [and], West Paterson and North
- 11 Haledon in Passaic county, for the following purposes:
- 12 a. The use of said intercepting sewer and its appurtenances and
- 13 for participation in the benefits and in the cost of the construction,
- 14 operation and maintenance of the same.
- 15 b. To permit any municipality already a party to the original
- 16 contract to allot a portion of its capacity in said sewer to any other
- 17 municipality within the drainage area for the purpose of providing
- 18 an outlet for the sewage of such other municipality.
- 19 The commissioners may, with like consent, enter into a contract
- 20 with any person owning or occupying lands in said drainage area
- 21 for the use of said intercepting sewer and appurtenances, and for
- 22 participation in the benefits and in the cost of construction and
- 23 maintenance of the same.
- 24 All of said contracts shall be entered into by the commissioners
- 25 upon such terms and conditions as may be agreed upon in any EXPLANATION—Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted in the law.

26 such contract, and any moneys paid in accordance with the terms of such further contract by such municipality or person may be 27 28 used and applied by the commissioners to the cost of the comple-29 tion of the intercepting sewer and appurtenances, or to the payment of the cost of the operation and maintenance of the same, or 30 to the reduction of the amount which any contracting municipality 31 32 may be called upon to pay to the commissioners by virtue of its 33 said contract, as may be agreed upon in any such contract.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

#### STATEMENT

This bill is permissive in character and would permit the borough of North Haledon located in Passaic county to enter into a lease agreement with the Passaic Valley Sewerage Commissioners to receive sewerage effluent. At the present time municipalities located within the drainage area of the Passaic river between the Great falls of Paterson and Newark bay, together with Totowa and West Paterson, are permitted to enter into such leases. This bill would merely extend the area to include North Haledon.
