INTRODUCED MAY 2, 1974

AN ACT concerning alcoholic beverages, and supplementing chapter 1 of Title 33 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. It shall be lawful for the municipal issuing authority of any
2 municipality having a population of more than 20,000 and located
3 in a county having a population between 800,000 and 1,200,000 in
4 which a referendum has been held pursuant to the provisions of
5 R. S. 33:1-45, wherein a majority of the legal voters of said munic-
6 ipality voted "No," to the question "Shall the retail sale of all kinds
7 of alcoholic beverages, for consumption on the licensed premises
8 by the glass or other open receptacle pursuant to chapter 1 of Title
9 33, Intoxicating Liquors, of the Revised Statutes (R. S. 33:1-1
10 et seq.) be permitted in this municipality?", and where club licenses
11 have been issued pursuant to P. L. 1949, c. 255, to issue an addi-
12 tional club license as defined in and regulated by subparagraph 5
13 of R. S. 33:1-12, after public hearing held at least 10 days after
14 publication of notice thereof and favorable vote by said authority,
15 to any constituent unit, chartered or otherwise duly enfranchised
16 chapter or member club of a national organization or association
17 which is in possession of suitable premises and which is operated
18 for benevolent, charitable, fraternal, social, religious, recreational,
19 athletic, or similar purposes, and not for private gain, and which
20 comply with all conditions which may be imposed by the Director
21 of the Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control in the Department
22 of Law and Public Safety.

23 This act shall be operative only during the 90-day period
24 immediately following its effective date, and thereafter shall be
25 inoperative.

26 Any license issued by said municipality during the said operative

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27 period shall entitle the holder of the license to retain it and any
28 renewals thereof notwithstanding that this act shall so become
29 inoperative.

30 Nothing herein contained shall be deemed to affect any license
31 or renewal thereof heretofore issued pursuant to P. L. 1949, c. 255.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

The purpose of this bill is to permit the issuance of an additional club license by a municipality of more than 20,000 inhabitants in a county having a population between 800,000 and 1,200,000 inhabitants to a unit of a national organization operated for benevolent, charitable, fraternal, social, athletic or similar purposes, and not for private gain.
