AN ACT concerning the compensation of the mayor and the commissioners in certain second-class cities located in counties of the third class, and supplementing chapter 72 of Title 40 of the Revised Statutes.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the board of com-  
2 missioners of any city of the second class governed by the commis-  
3 sion form of government law located in a county of the third class,  
4 and having a population of more than 20,000 inhabitants as  
5 ascertained by the latest Federal census, may by ordinance fix the  
6 annual salary of the mayor at not more than \$7,500.00 and of the  
7 remaining members of the commission at not more than \$7,000.00  
8 each.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

Assembly Bill No. 1513 provides a new salary schedule for mayors and commissioners in certain second class cities under a commission form of government.

This bill provides new maximum salary levels for the mayors and commissioners of any city of the second class under a commission form of government with a population of more than 20,000 and located in a county of the third class.

This bill exclusively affects the city of Millville which prior to the 1970 Federal Census, operated under the provisions of P. L. 1960, c. 70 (C. 40:72-24.11), as amended, pertaining to cities of the second class with a population of between 12,000 and 20,000.

As Millville's population, according to the 1970 Federal Census, exceeded 20,000, the governing body of that municipality is compelled by R. S. 40:72-25 to reset the salaries for mayor and commissioners on the basis of the new population figures. Thus, in accordance with R. S. 40:72-21, as amended, and R. S. 40:72-24, the salary of the mayor of Millville may currently be set not in excess of \$6,000.00 and that of each commissioner not in excess of \$5,250.00.

Under the provisions of P. L. 1960, c. 70, the mayor of Millville was eligible to receive a salary not in excess of \$5,000.00 and each commissioner a salary not in excess of \$4,500.00.

This bill would set the new maximums at \$7,500.00 and \$7,000.00.
