DATED: FEBRUARY 13, 1975

This bill amends the "Absentee Voting Law (1953)" (P. L. 1953, c. 211) to require that the list of candidates for local offices be printed on the absentee ballot. The statute (C. 19:57–14) presently requires that a list of candidates for local office be sent with the absentee ballots. This amendment, by requiring that these candidates be printed on the ballot itself, is aimed at reducing the confusion and errors which occur in the process of transferring choices from a separate list to the official absentee ballot.
