AN ACT concerning the term of office of the Director of the Division  
of Motor Vehicles and amending R. S. 39:2-2.

1 BE IT ENACTED *by the Senate and General Assembly of the State*  
2 *of New Jersey:*

1 1. R. S. 39:2-2 is amended to read as follows:

2 39:2-2. The division shall be administered by the Director of the  
3 Division of Motor Vehicles.

4 The director shall be appointed by the Governor with the advice  
5 and consent of the Senate and shall serve **[during the term of office]**  
6 *at the pleasure of the Governor* **[appointing him]** *during the Gov-*  
7 *ernor's term of office* and until the director's successor is appointed  
8 and has qualified.

9 The director shall receive such salary as shall be provided by law.

10 The director shall give bond, conditioned for the faithful dis-  
11 charge of his duties, in the sum of \$50,000.00, which bond shall be  
12 approved by a justice of the supreme court or a judge of the  
13 superior court, and shall be filed with the State Treasurer.

14 The director shall take an oath before one of the supreme court  
15 justices or superior court judges, in form similar to that now  
16 required by the State Treasurer, which oath shall be filed with the  
17 Secretary of State.

1 2. This act shall take effect immediately.

STATEMENT

The purpose of this bill is to provide that the Director of the  
Division of Motor Vehicles shall serve at the pleasure of the Gov-  
ernor during the term of office of the Governor.
